



Call for Corporate Collaborator

The nature of this project is collaboration – and not just for the arts. The artists will be discussing and creating visual representations of collaboration – but the conversation is larger than that. It is about all of us, all of Kingston, working together across disciplines. From pottery to fibre, but also from artists to governments to private sector.

The City of Kingston is going through major transitions right now. With the development of our Cultural Plan, the unknown future of the Tett Centre, the revitalization of our Grand, the major shifts in our downtown, we are seeing both disappointment and excitement. We are seeing a need and desire for EVERYONE to collaborate.

Kollaboration Kingston is a project founded on this principle. We want to provide a positive conversation starter. To do so we have received support from the Ontario Arts Council. We were 1 of only 6 groups across the province to receive funding. However, we are just short of our budget by \$750.

This call for corporate collaborators is an opportunity for businesses to show their support and desire for our community to collaborate. The money will be used to document the process of collaboration. The process will be documented on film, both video and still. It will be distributed on the web through multiple blogs, Facebook and the www.ktownartists.ca website.

In exchange for your collaboration (minimum \$250) you will be given logo identification on our website, blog, other online media outlets, rack card and films. You will be invited to the show opening, which will be a great time to engage in community discussions. You will also be given a hard copy of the films associated with the project.
